Monotheism	Belief in one God
Bhagavad Gita	An important religious text in Hinduism



1.3. Beliefs about worship	
Puja	  This is Hindu worship .
Mandir	A Hindu temple
Arti	A ceremony used to welcome the deity . It involves the use of light as a blessing.
Murti	Images or statues of a god are placed on the shrine, during worship.
Sewa	  Service to the deity or holy people
Bhajan	Songs (hymns)
Kirtan	Mantras (chants) – this is where phrases or words will be repeated to the beat of music.

1.4. Beliefs about life after death	
karma	   The results of your actions i.e. good actions have good consequences in the afterlife.
samsara	   'To flow' - The cycle of birth, life, death and rebirth .
Atman	The soul or spirit of an individual .
moksha	The idea that the soul is released from the cycle of samsara in Hinduism.
caste	Class or level/standing in society . Hindus believe that the caste a person is born into is decided by their karma.
